### INSTRUMENTAL TUITION 2018

Instrumental tuition is offered in the following instruments: violin, flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, guitar, bass guitar, vocals, keyboard and drums. However, the availability of tuition does depend on the number of students interested.

Pupils receive approximately 32 lessons per annum. (8 lessons per term)  
Lessons are held during school time in groups of 2-5 students.

#### FEES:

The fees are: \$280.00 per annum or \$80.00 per term.

Fees are required to be paid before lessons commence in Week 3, Term 1.

Fees are required to be paid in the last week of the term, if lessons are to continue the following term.

Invoices are NOT sent out but reminders are given via the school newsletter and daily notices.

There will be additional costs for tutor books, photocopying, folders, reeds, drum sticks or hire of instruments.

#### INSTRUMENTS:

Violin and guitar students must provide their own instrument.

Flutes, clarinets, saxophones, trumpets, trombones and 1 drum kit may be hired from school.

Keyboard, bass guitar and drum students may use the school instruments for lessons but need their own instruments for practice at home.

#### PUPIL OBLIGATIONS:

It is important that pupils are aware of their obligations with regard to music tuition. Please discuss the following with your child:

- **LESSON DAYS/TIMES** – pupils must know the time/day/venue of their weekly lesson and ensure they arrive promptly. Information regarding lessons is posted on the notice board outside the drama room or in the daily notices. It is the pupil's responsibility to read the notices and get to their lessons on time.
- **PREPARATION** – pupils are expected to practise at home and turn up to lessons fully prepared with their instrument and music.
- **COMMUNICATION** – parents/caregivers must inform the office by Week 2 of each term if a pupil no longer wishes to learn an instrument. There are no refunds.
- **COMMITMENT** – pupils have made a commitment to learn an instrument – stay with it because this is a wonderful opportunity.

### THEORY CLUB

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Due to time limitations, it is difficult for itinerant teachers to teach the theory of music at the same time as practical music. Theory club allows students to work through the ABRSM grade system and the opportunity to sit an international exam at the end of the year.

Lessons are in school time and the fees are: \$280.00 per annum or \$80.00 per term. There are additional charges for the workbook, approximately \$15 and the examination fee, approximately \$69.

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**Fees for Instrumental Hire**

Flute, clarinet, trumpet and trombone      \$50 per annum  
Saxophone and drum kit                      \$100 per annum
